What is APF-Mill Hill?

The APF (Association for the Propagation of the Faith) assists each of the Catholic Church's 1,069 mission dioceses to provide pastoral care and preach the Gospel effectively. It was founded by a young French woman, Pauline Jaricot in 1822 who began by persuading local working people to support the missions by giving a farthing a week. It is now the official mission-funding charity of the Catholic Church.

Mill Hill Missionaries was one of the first societies to introduce lay missionaries, and the only major missionary society founded in England. Its priests, brothers and lay associates work in 27 countries on every continent.

APF and Mill Hill receive no external funding or grants; they depend entirely on the direct support of Catholic individuals and parishes.

APF and Mill Hill work together as a joint parish-based organisation, mandated by the Bishops to make a five-yearly membership appeal in each parish. Their activity stays true to the principles of Pauline Jaricot by relying on lay supporters and volunteers to support the developing Church. The famous APF-Mill Hill Red Box is now held in over 200,000 Catholic homes, and has raised millions of pounds to fund the front-line mission work by APF and Mill Hill Missionaries in some of the poorest and most isolated parts of the world.

You can join us on any step of the volunteer ladder

- ← Become a trained APF-MHM applier, making appeals for new members in parishes within your diocese

- ← Become an APF Promoter, visiting parishioners to empty their Red Boxes and take them copies of *Mission Today* magazine
- ← Support our children's charity Mission Together in local schools by giving assemblies in primary schools in your diocese
- ← Help to organise a mission evening or fundraising event (such as a coffee morning) in your area
- ← Help out with an appeal in your area (handing out magazines, signing up Red Box holders, members or other volunteers)
- ← Organise a group from your parish to attend a Mission Mass in your area
- ← Help to promote the Novena to St Joseph which precedes the Feast of St Joseph (19 March) every year
