### Competition: Design a Postcard for Mission Together!

To celebrate Pope Francis' Extraordinary Month of Mission in October 2019, we're inviting children in England and Wales aged between 5 and 14 to design a postcard.

As Christians, we all have a mission: to share God's love with the whole world. No one is too young or too small to take part. Through Mission Together, children everywhere pray for and share with one another in a unique exchange of love and friendship.

This October, Pope Francis is asking children to make a special effort to share God's love around the world.

#### Competition time

To mark this special occasion, Mission Together, the children's branch of Missio, would like you to design a postcard, showing how Mission Together helps children all over the world live out their mission, by feeding hungry people with food and hope; offering those who are thirsty water and faith and helping people who are sick with medicine and prayers.

The theme of the design is:

**'Our Mission: To Share God's Love with the Whole World'**

There are three categories and one winner will be chosen from each category:

Ages 5-7

Ages 8-11

Ages 12-14

We will print the winning entries as postcards, to give to children across the country at Masses and Liturgies during the Extraordinary Month of Mission.

#### Competition rules and instructions

- The drawing / painting must be on paper of A6 size (148mm x 105mm)
- The theme 'Our Mission: To Share God's Love with the Whole World' should be the focus of the design and reflect the work of children who support Mission Together worldwide.
- Participants can use pencil, crayon, paint or a computer drawing. The completed artwork must be flat.
- The name and age of the participant along with the school/parish name and address must be clearly written on the back of the drawing/painting.
- One entry per child is permitted. Each entry should be an individual effort.

All entries submitted for competition shall become the property of Missio.

The competition is open to children living in England and Wales at the time of submission of the entry.
