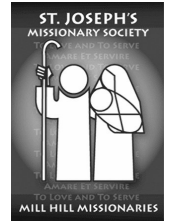

Re-connecting with your Red Box holders

Many parishes are slowly and carefully gathering together. This presents an opportunity for us to re-connect with the many Red Box holders and online donors in our parishes. You may wish to consider some of the following ideas from fellow Local Secretaries:

- **Red Box Amnesty.** Ask people to bring in their Box for emptying over a few weekends, and check the details you have for them.
- **Prayer.** Invite your Red Box holders and the wider parish community to come together for a time of Mission prayer and sharing during Advent. You can watch our Advent reflections as a group and join the Missio community in prayer and reflection.
- **Remembrance.** Gather for a meal / refreshments to remember and celebrate members of your parish Red Box community who have gone to their heavenly reward. Share stories of your friends and relatives who supported the missions in their lifetime.

Annual Return Forms for 2021

You will receive your Annual Return Forms in the post in February. Even if you have been unable to collect money this year, please still return the forms as it assists with our checks and balances. It helps us to update our records (please note any changes e.g. new parish priest), that we can claim any Gift Aid we're entitled to, and that we correctly attribute the generous funds, given to support missionaries around the world, as having come from your parish community.

Contactless Giving

We are trialling contactless giving in some parishes as an additional way that people can give. If you are interested in helping to trial the contactless devices, please get in touch.

It is one of the areas which came out of the Local Secretary Consultation, which is still ongoing, with working groups looking at specific areas of the Red Box: cashless giving, the role of the Local Secretary, resources, and training. Local Secretary Online Training

There are only two chances left in 2021 to join our online training and formation sessions.
